What does Mrs. Hart do?

What do students do?

Teaching on the carpet

Sit in STAR Listener position criss-cross applesauce on the carpet

Reading and writing

Track the speaker, be ready to ask and answer questions

Asking students to turn and talk

Knee to knee, eye to eye with your buddy
Listening and speaking to your PB & J Talking Buddy

Independent Reading



What does Mrs. Hart do?	What do students do?
Conferencing	Sit in their reading spot away from other readers
Listening to students read	Read at a "two-inch voice" for the whole time!
Taking small groups for reading	Practice your sight words, books and fluency folders

Small Groups



What does Mrs. Hart do?

What do students do?

Teach a small group

Sit at the kidney bean table and read warm books in the bin

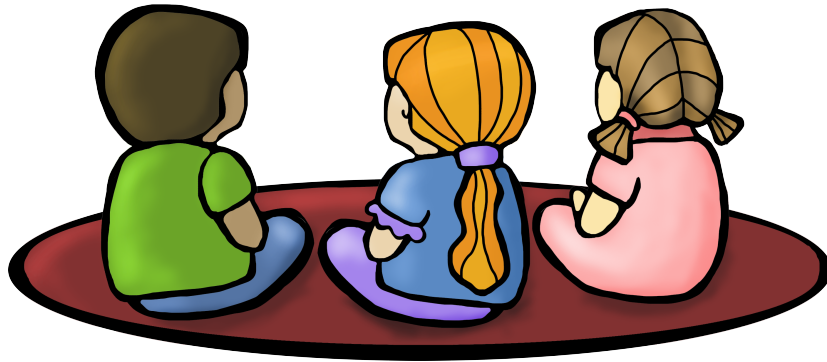
Listen to students read

Practice what Mrs. Hart is teaching you in the book

Ask questions and take notes

Students NOT with Mrs. Hart are still reading independently

Share Time



What does Mrs. Hart do?	What do students do?
Ask buddies to turn and talk	Sit on the perimeter of the carpet and turn and tell your PB & J buddy about your learning
Call on students to share new learning	Track the speaker and listen in STAR listener position
Look at student work	Look at the work of your classmates and ask questions
